Description

The Technical Director plays a significant role in the execution of the vision of Forest City Community Church. His/Her key responsibility is oversight of 1) the technical equipment and 2) the volunteer teams that execute the technical functions of FCCC services. Responsible for the execution of services from a technical standpoint, the technical director schedules and ensures that each technical team involved in a Sunday morning service is fully staffed and trained to accomplish a production that reflects FCCC's value of excellence and minimal distraction. We will also look to the Technical Director for supervision and support of the technical systems in the auditorium, as well as the rest of the campus. This means that the Technical Director must be willing to grow in understanding of the technology, grow in leadership skills, and grow in team building and recruitment.

The Technical Director reports to the Creative Arts Director.
